### **District Policy**

If the amount of time required by the custodian to research and retrieve public records necessary to fulfill a specific records request exceeds one hour, including the time required to identify and segregate records that must or may not be produced, the person or entity making the request shall be charged a research and retrieval fee of \$41.37 per hour. Such fee shall be automatically adjusted, without further approval by the Districts, to such amount established by the State Director of Research of the Legislative Council from time to time. The Districts will not impose a charge for the first hour of time expended in connection with the research and retrieval of public

records. This imposition of this fee shall be effective upon the publishing of this Public Records Policy in accordance with the Open Records Act.
